

To date, The Joseph Groh Foundation has provided financial assistance totaling **\$1.5 million to 150 families** with connections to the contracting and construction trades in 38 states. Below are a few of The Joseph Groh Foundation recipients from 2025.

Stanley Bray of Orange Beach, Alabama

- Stanley, a licensed electrician, sustained a C6 spinal cord injury that left him quadriplegic and unable to work or care for himself.
- The Joseph Groh Foundation funded critical home modifications, including an accessible shower and roll-under sink, to improve his daily independence.
- These changes have allowed Stanley to regain personal hygiene routines and support his family emotionally and practically.

Kris Luttrell of Gainesville, Texas

- Kris was a former roofing and HVAC contractor and sustained a C-4 to C-7 spinal injury in 2016 but has demonstrated remarkable resilience and ongoing commitment to recovery and career rebuilding.
- Despite setbacks, Kris has gained experience in insurance, construction, and management, and is now preparing to launch his own roofing business, Xactly Rite.
- The Joseph Groh Foundation provided tools and support to help Kris manage his business efficiently, with plans to expand and create opportunities for others with disabilities.

Steven Keller of Wilmington, North Carolina

- Steven, an experienced electrical engineer, was critically injured by a high-voltage electrocution in 2016, leading to severe injuries and a long recovery process.
- Due to limited funds after his accident, Steven was unable to retrofit his home for accessibility and needed support for necessary modifications.
- The Joseph Groh Foundation provided a bath remodel, helping Steven improve his home's accessibility and regain independence.

Dalton Dague of Mount Vernon, Ohio

- Dalton, a young diesel mechanic, was paralyzed at T4 after a UTV accident, and is now dealing with the challenges of paraplegia.
- He experienced improvements through rehabilitation and was advised to continue using an FES cycle at home to aid recovery, which was beyond his financial means.
- The Joseph Groh Foundation provided the FES cycle, inspiring Dalton's determination to regain mobility and prove skeptics wrong, despite his ongoing physical challenges.

Jeff Paul of Malden, Massachusetts

- Jeff, a radiologist and general contractor, was paralyzed at the C7 vertebrae after a car accident, ending his ability to work.
- He struggled with daily tasks like showering and bathroom use, seeking greater independence.
- The Foundation provided a bathroom remodel, enabling Jeff to regain some independence and improve his quality of life.

ABOUT THE COURSE

Eldorado Country Club is a private facility featuring an 18-hole championship golf course designed by Gary Roger Baird. The par 72 course was established in 1981 and is

known for its tight, tree-lined fairways, well-bunkered greens and two lakes. Perhaps the signature feature of the course are its challenging, sloped greens. From the white tees, the course stretches 6188 yards and has a course rating of 70.7. The slope rating from the white tees is 135, making it an excellent course for best ball tournaments.
