- Tyler worked for his father's roofing firm in Seattle
- Tyler was paralyzed at C3 after diving into a shallow lake
- Received assistive technology (voice operated) items

Jason Wuestewald of South Dakota

- Jason was a self-employed roofer in Yankton
- Jason was paralyzed at C6 as the result of a motor vehicle accident
- Received pressure relieving mattress to prevent pressure ulcers

Josh Yardley of Missouri

- Josh owned a small general contracting firm near Springfield
- Josh was paralyzed at C7 as the result of a motor vehicle accident
- Received remodeled bathroom for accessibility & a shower chair

Roberto Hernandez of Illinois

- Roberto was a union laborer for Lombard Construction in Chicago
- Roberto had a stroke causing paralysis on his left side & speech delay
- Received outdoor elevator facilitating wheelchair entry to home

Addison Fichtel of Michigan

- Addison's father worked for his brothers HVAC contracting firm
- Addison is nonverbal, and was born with cerebral palsy
- Addison received a wheelchair accessible van
