Frank Carter of Spavubaw, OK

- Frank was a Veteran powerline mechanic (LA Trade-Tech) who worked nationwide and joined IBEW/MSLCAT.
- Suffered a C5–C6 spinal cord injury on Oct 11, 2024, is quadriplegic, awaiting SSDI, and struggled with bathing.
- Received a donor-funded portable Shower Bay accessible stall, enabling safe showers without remodeling.

Victor Bentley of Plattsville, CO

- Victor, a 15-year union ironworker in Platteville, CO; completed a three-year apprenticeship and worked on major regional projects.
- Paralyzed by a 2024 crash on black ice (T5 complete); aims to return to ironwork, mentor apprentices, and become a crane operator.

- Received donor-funded hand controls and a Firefly motorized wheelchair attachment, restoring driving independence and enabling race car driving.

Ralph Pouncey Jr of Mountainburg, AR

- Ralph is a Nearly 30-year trades professional (HVAC technician to service manager) known for reliability and skill.
- Fell 30ft in May 2024 clearing debris, sustained a T3 ASIA A complete spinal cord injury and lost ability to work.
- Received Foundation support to obtain a MyoCycle FES bike for home use to improve health, strength, and independence.

Alicia Reagan of LaFayette, GA

- Alicia was paralyzed in 2009, Alicia built a marketing/design career and worked in HVAC.
- In 2021 the Foundation funded a vehicle-access concrete pad.
- Donors (Trane + brother) funded HVAC system materials and installation for her home.

Matthew Ohmann of Inver Grove Heights, MN

- Matthew is a 38-year electrician (IBEW) who rose to field supervisor.
- Health issues and a right above-knee amputation ended his career and impaired mobility.
- JGF funded vinyl flooring to improve home safety for prosthetic use.
